




You will receive information in the coming weeks about programs to support you and your child:


- ★ **Seesaw** is the online learning system NNPS Preschool uses to communicate with families and provide additional learning opportunities for students (both in and out of the classroom!)

Your preschooler will be assigned an iPad, with built-in Wi-Fi, to support learning experiences in the classroom.




We work with students to develop and understand the appropriate way to use devices and how to use them as an educational tool

Families are students' **FIRST** and **FOREVER** teachers. Please help provide the best school experience for your child by ensuring he or she:


- ✓ attends school on time, every day
- ✓ wears the supplied name tag to school every day
- ✓ benefits from the full instructional day
- ✓ has a responsible person meeting them at school or the bus with the yellow pick-up card
- ✓ has several local emergency numbers on file in ParentVue
- ✓ has a change of clothes, updated throughout the year for appropriate weather, because accidents happen 😊
- ✓ wears appropriate school shoes for indoor and outdoor play (please no flip flops, sandals, or heels)




Home-School Partnership

Please partner with us further by:

- ✓ updating contact information in ParentVue as needed
- ✓ sharing essential information regarding health and behavior concerns with your child's teacher
- ✓ supporting your child's learning by asking your child questions and encouraging a positive attitude
- ✓ discussing and encouraging appropriate school behavior
- ✓ attending a conference with your child's teacher 2 times a year
- ✓ attending family nights/workshops throughout the year
- ✓ cooperating with requests from the school staff regarding instruction and safety





School Supplies-Optional

- 2 Packs of crayons or markers
- 2 Packs of pencils
- 1 Pack of dry erase markers
- 4 Large glue sticks
- Change of clothes

Please note that supplies may need to be replenished throughout the year.

Optional community supplies: tissues, hand sanitizer, or zip-loc bags (quart or gallon size), may be donated at any time.

Attendance

Absence

- The NNPS Preschool program begins your child's attendance record, which is part of their permanent educational record.
- If your child is absent, you will receive an automated phone message.
- If your child is sick, your child must be symptom-free for at least 24 hours before returning to school.
- Please send a note with your child when he/she returns to school explaining the reason for the absence so the absence can be documented as excused.


Tardy

- The preschool morning is specifically designed to allow your child a calm, healthy start to his or her day.
- Please help your child succeed by arriving on time daily; instilling this daily practice teaches students accountability and respect.

Excessive and unexcused absenteeism can lead to your child being withdrawn from the NNPS Preschool program




Meals



Breakfast & Lunch

- Breakfast and lunch are served daily and provided at no cost to students
- Your child may bring a lunch from home if you prefer
- School lunch calendars are available on the NNPS website
- Parents are always welcome to have lunch with their child
- Please work with your child to begin learning how to independently open their food and drink containers

Bathroom



- School staff members work on helping children be successful and independent with clean, healthy toileting procedures

- Children are expected and encouraged to go to the bathroom and clean themselves independently



- Please practice and prepare your child as the school environment may be a new experience
- Teachers may reach out to families to talk to and work with their child if bathroom difficulties are noticed


Name Tags

- All preschool students will receive a personalized name tag and required to ***wear to and from school every day***
- Establish a safe-keeping spot at home for your student to easily access his or her own tag each morning
- Please send all notes and information to school in your child's name tag
- Remember to **check tags daily** for important information, such as:
 - ☐ School flyers and announcements
 - ☐ Correspondence from classroom teachers
 - ☐ Memos and information from the school office




Drop-Off Procedures

- All Drop-Off Procedures are for the safety and benefit of all students, families, and staff.
- We strongly encourage you to have your child ride the bus to and from school, beginning the first day.
- If you choose to drive your child to school, a staff member will receive your child in front of the school starting at 9:30 AM.
 - To keep all children and staff safe, please:
 - ✓ Follow traffic rules in the parking lot
 - ✓ Please watch for children & adults walking between cars
 - ✓ Walk your child to the front door
 - ✓ Please be on time - 9:30-9:45
 - ✓ After 9:45, you will need to enter the building & check your child in tard



Pick-Up Procedures

- All Pick-Up Procedures are for the safety and benefit of all students, families, and staff.
- Each family will be given a total of a 3 yellow pick-up cards. This card will need to be presented to pick up your child.
- Students can be picked up from the cafeteria from 3:40-4:00 PM. Here you will show your yellow card and sign your child out.
- If a child needs to be picked up early, please call the office.
- Please ensure students are able to benefit from a full day of school as much as possible.



Bus Information



- Bus assignments and bus stop information will be available at Open House.
- Please review bus rules with your child daily - students are expected to be able to sit throughout the entire bus ride and keep hands and feet to themselves.
- To keep your child safe, a **yellow** NNPS Identification Card **must be presented daily** in order to receive your child off the bus.
- **Bus drivers will return students to school** *if an authorized person is not present with the NNPS Identification Card*. Failure to meet your child at the bus 3 times may result in the loss of bus privileges for your student.


Who is Eligible?
Children under the age of five in Hampton Roads, VA.

What Are My Responsibilities?

1. Be a resident of Hampton News, York County, Hampton, James City/Williamsburg City County, Isle of Wight, Poquoson or by the authorized adult.
2. Submit an official registration form, completely filled out by the authorized adult.
3. Notify The DeGood Foundation any time your address changes. Books are mailed to the address listed on the account. Note: If the child's address changes, you must contact your friends at the address on file in order to continue receiving books.
4. Read with your child and have fun!

When Will I Receive Books?
Eight to ten weeks after your registration form has been received, books will begin arriving at your home and will continue until your child turns five or you move out of the covered area.
